The Neighborhood Blessings program began about seven years ago when our volunteers recognized how many people in Hernando County were homeless and living in poverty. The program was created with the mission to provide people a hot meal and some much-needed items to aid in their daily lives. The implementation of the program is carried out with the help of our volunteers, who drive to designated locations and dispense the food and goods to those who live in the woods, in a tent, their car, a shed, or others who have extremely limited resources. Meals and some essentials like tents, bikes, sleeping bags, bug sprays, sleeping mats, toiletries, groceries are distributed by volunteers on Tuesdays and Fridays. (During the Covid-19 crisis, the distribution was limited.)
