# FREE CLINIC TUESDAYS AT THE HELP CENTER

People Helping People (PHP) is pleased to announce that our Free Health Clinic is now open every Tuesday of the month from 10am to 1pm, at our 1396 Kass Circle HELP Center. Eligibility I ncludes those uninsured and low-income people seeking medical attention for chronic or general medical issues.

Two and a half years ago, Maureen Soliman, RN, BSN, Master in Healthcare Administration, and future PHP Board member, brought friend Dr. Elaine Moorman, APRN, to see the PHP facility. They formed a plan, and so the Free Clinic began.

The PHP Board agreed to open the Free Health Clinic, and Maureen and Dr. Moorman, who had prior experience in this field, paved the way. They, along with volunteers Ardis Ligman and Phoebe Perez, RNs, Bruce Resitch, LPN, and Cleoann Druzbick, Patient Resource Coordinator, launched operations and began seeing patients.

The Free Health Clinic is accredited, trained, and regulated by the Florida



Department of Health. All volunteers for this program must go through strict training. Some of the chronic health issues seen at the

> skin infections (common in the unsheltered population), high blood pressure, diabetes, COPD, and other respiratory illnesses. Previously, Covid vaccinations were offered.

When patients arrive, they are assessed, vitals are taken, and their current health situation is discussed. Next, they see Dr.

Moorman for a physical exam, are assigned a treatment plan, and if necessary, are referred to Premiere Healthcare for expanded services.

The PHP Free Health Clinic also partners with America's Best pharmacy to offer free eye exam vouchers, and in the future, we look to include a mental health component, and dental exams as well.

For Maureen Soliman, helping others is in her blood. She comes from a family of first responders and those employed in Human Services. "The strong help the weak. That's my mantra and that's what we are able to do at People Helping People and the Free Health Clinic."

Hi, there! I am Kendra, the new Executive Director for People Helping People in Hernando County, and in

the short time I've been here I have been introduced to people and programs that go beyond my anticipation.

PHP is fortunate to have a strong core group of people who volunteer their time, energy, and spirit to do whatever part they can to work toward our mission of alleviating hunger in Hernando County.

Some pack bags of food that are then delivered to kids at several local schools so they have something to eat over the weekend – our **Weekend Blessings** program. Others do the same for seniors in local communities – our Senior Blessings program . There is a team of folks that packs hot meals and delivers them to those who are living in the woods or other unsheltered areas - our Neighborhood Blessings program. Our volunteers also serve restaurant quality food as a hot meal on a Sunday – our Sunday Blessings program. Our volunteers include a team of healthcare providers who will tend to your health issues - our Free Health Clinic. We have a volunteer who will go just about anywhere to pick up donated food so we can add to our emergency food inventory. And, this place couldn't operate without proper maintenance, keeping our facility clean and running well. Again, it's volunteers that do that.

Why do they do all this? Because they have a servant's heart. Because they need to pay back or want to pay forward. And, yes, some because they want to fill their day and enjoy social interaction. Whatever the reason, People Helping People couldn't help people without them.
